The purpose of this internship is to outreach to men on campus and collaborate with the student groups on campus that are primarily male on behalf of Men Against Rape (MAR). The goal is to make MAR a strong and visible presence on the UCSB campus and in the Isla Vista community. The intern would ensure that men in the community are aware of the resources available on campus and in the community. The intern would be responsible for inviting male-oriented groups on campus, as well as individual men, to collaborate with and/or get involved in MAR to develop projects designed for men that recognize the role men have in combating sexual violence.

Training for all interns is mandatory. Training will consist of 12 hours during Fall Qtr.

Requirements:

Attend 2 weekly meetings
Commit 40 hours per quarter
Fall, Winter, Spring Quarters**

\$1,500 stipend**
